OVERVIEW

LET'S Talk Consent(LTC) in collaboration with Ashesi University wrote a training manual for a sex education based on a consent culture and also ran a facilitator training workshop. The event was attended by lecturers, teaching assistants and students. This was a big win for us because for the 1st time since we started running LTC, a university has mainstreamed our consent - based workshops in their orientation program.

After writing the manual, Akosua ran a facilitators' workshop for a group of about 30 people. She was the facilitator on the ground. As said earlier attendance included lecturers, teaching assistants and students on how to run a sexual consent workshop. This group will run workshops for first years during orientation at Ashesi. The workshop was fun, educative and interactive. As part of the workshop, the participants were asked to imagine what a school with consent culture will look like and participants drew on sheets and had these drawings pasted all over the school.
